ALIANTE STATION GAMING FACT SHEET

Overview:

Aliante Station Casino + Hotel offers all of the gaming amenities guests have come to expect and enjoy at a Station Casinos property. North Las Vegas' newest locals' casino resort offers nearly 2000 of the newest and most popular slots, a 12-table smoke-free poker room and 40 table games including blackjack, roulette, craps and pai gow. The casino floor features something for everyone, with the newest and traditional reel games like Monopoly, Wheel of Fortune, Star Trek and Deal or No Deal. And players need not worry about a halt in the action, because with the first Ethernet-based slot floor in the Las Vegas Valley, the floor will never go down. Aliante Station also offers a high-limit room more with more than 40 games, eight games on the high-limit bar, a slot cage and five table games.

Slot/Video Poker Machines and Table Games:

Guests can enjoy nearly 2,000 slot/video poker machines including plenty of penny-based games (many of which are part of the multi-denomination slot machines). The casino floor offers 40 table games including black jack, roulette, craps, mini-baccarat and midi-baccarat.

Poker Room:

The 12-table, smoke free poker room was designed to emulate a masculine, cigar bar feel. Games widely available include \$1/\$3 no limit Hold 'Em, \$2/\$5 no limit Hold 'Em as well as both low and high limit Hold 'Em. Guests who play at least 50 hours of poker during the months of November and December will be eligible for a free seat in the \$300,000 Poker Plus tournament to be held in January. In addition, at the start of the year, ladies nights and couples tournaments will be held weekly.

Race & Sports Book:

Whether you're playing the ponies or enjoying the big game, the race and sports book at Aliante Station has a seat for you. Actually, there are 170 seats; all with spectacular views of nearly 200 television screens including 24 65-inch LCD TV screens, 126 individual viewing stations, each featuring a 15-inch LCD screen that is equipped with ear phone adaptors and another 35 LCD screens displayed throughout the race and sports book lounge. The space's most impressive feature is the three video screens that span the entire wall of the race and sports Book area. Together, the three giant screens total 96-feet in length by 18-feet in height. The video walls are fueled by 18 projectors and have become the most popular screens in Vegas to watch games. The Race & Sports Book will offer a limited bar menu with tableside service. And getting there couldn't be more convenient. The Race & Sports Book is located directly off the parking garage with an option to self-park or utilize the property's valet.

Hours: 8 a.m. to midnight Monday through Thursday, 8 a.m. to 3 a.m. on Friday, 6 a.m. to 3 a.m. on Saturday and 6 a.m. to midnight on Sunday.
