### PROPERTY FACT SHEET

#### OVERVIEW

Palace Station Hotel and Casino is the original flagship property of the Station Casinos properties in southern Nevada. Located on more than 38 acres on Sahara Avenue adjacent to Interstate 15 and just west of the Las Vegas Strip, Palace Station was opened by Frank Fertitta, Jr. as "The Casino" on July 1, 1976. After a series of expansions, including the building of a 21-story hotel tower, the new Palace Station Hotel and Casino was introduced in 1991 when Frank Fertitta III and Lorenzo Fertitta took over the family business from their father, just two years before taking the Company public in 1993.

Palace Station's 122,608 square feet of space includes more than 1,000 hotel rooms, more than 17,000 square feet of meeting and event space, more than 1,800 slot and video poker machines, the famed Palace Station Showroom and a selection of full service restaurants.

#### DESIGN

Guests visiting Palace Station enjoy the relaxed atmosphere and "Vegas" feel of Station Casinos' original property. An emphasis on convenience and ease of access to gaming and dining options is evident throughout.

#### CASINO

Palace Station's variety of slot machines and table games means there's something for everyone, including the most Baccarat and Pai Gow tile games off the Strip. Palace Station was the first property in Las Vegas to provide table-side food service in the pit.

## HOTEL

Palace Station offers several reasonably priced options for hotel guests. The 430 Courtyard rooms are all non-smoking and located nearest to the pool area. A glass elevator ride up from the casino floor brings guests to the newly renovated 556 deluxe tower rooms which feature views of either the Las Vegas Strip, Downtown Las Vegas or the surrounding mountains. Each room includes cable TV, internet access, dataport phones, in-room safes, hair dryers and ironing boards. The top floor of the 21-story tower is home to 20 tastefully appointed suites, including six Grand Suites:



- **Grand Suites:** 1,100 square feet; living room with bar and dining area; master bath with separate Jacuzzi tub and shower, additional 1/2 bath; three TVs—60-inch plasma in the living room, 27-inch in the bedroom and a 10-inch in the bathroom.

## DINING

Enjoy one of Palace Station's seven full-service restaurants:

- **The Broiler:** Las Vegas' premier choice for prime-grade steaks, fresh fish and live Maine lobster. The Broiler is open for lunch and dinner from 11AM to 10PM, Monday through Thursday, and 11AM to 11PM, Friday through Sunday. Reservations are recommended by calling 702.221.6678.
- **Pasta Palace:** Enjoy fresh pasta and antipasto in an authentic Italian atmosphere voted Best Italian Restaurant three years in a row by the

Las Vegas Review-Journal. Pasta Palace is open for dinner from 4PM to 9PM, Sunday through Thursday, and 5PM to 10PM, Friday and Saturday. Reservations are recommended by calling 702.221.6679.

- **Cabo Mexican Restaurant:** Features authentic Mexican Baja dishes and salsas. Fresh guacamole is prepared tableside, and a variety of margaritas are served up inside or outside on the patio. Cabo is open for dinner from 5PM to 10PM, Sunday through Thursday, and from 5PM to 11PM, Friday and Saturday. The bar at Cabo is open from 4PM to 1AM daily.
- **Oyster Bar:** Live-action dishes prepared before your eyes, including steamed clams, freshly shucked oysters, homemade chowders, gumbos and seafood pastas. The Oyster Bar is open for lunch and dinner from 11AM to 11PM, Sunday through Thursday, and 11AM to 1AM, Friday and Saturday.
- **Food Express Chinese:** Authentic Cantonese cuisine, including traditional favorites and exotic specialties. Open for lunch and dinner from 11AM to 3AM.
- **Coco's Bakery & Restaurant:** The popular 24-hour popular 24-hour family dining restaurant that serves up hearty breakfast, lunch and dinner specialties, but is probably best known for its bakeries that feature fresh baked pies, cakes, cookies, muffins and breads baked fresh daily at each location.
- **Feast Gourmet Buffet:** The newly renovated buffet offers freshly prepared food from around the world at five live-action cooking stations serving American, Asian, Italian bistro, South of the Border (Mexican) and traditional BBQ. Breakfast is served 7AM to 11AM, lunch from 11AM to 4PM weekdays, and dinner from 4PM to 10PM daily. Weekend brunch is served from 7AM to 4PM.
- **Food Court:** Provides additional offerings from recognized brands including Starbucks and Subway.
- **In-Room Dining:** A variety of offerings is available 24 hours a day.
