



Resort Fact Sheet

Overview

The hotel at Red Rock Casino, Spa and Resort is a contemporary desert retreat with an intimate boutique feel. A separate hotel entrance that allows guests to conveniently access their rooms without having to cross the casino floor sets Red Rock apart from other luxury resorts in Las Vegas by allowing the option for a true retreat or to partake in the excitement of Vegas under one roof.

Featuring a chic, ultra-modern look and designed with only the finest materials, the guest rooms and suites at Red Rock Casino, Resort and Spa offer complete sanctuary. Exotic woods, marble, crystal and sumptuous fabrics adorn each room, and all rooms also offer spectacular views of either the Las Vegas Strip or the Red Rock mountains. Rich browns and clean whites are the foundation of the color palette, and convey a feeling of comfortable elegance and warmth.

Rack rates range from \$159 for a standard room to as much as \$10,000 per night for the largest and most lavish suites. The resort offers more than 800 rooms, including 55 suites in six styles, as well as a four-acre pool backyard area, premiere shops, meeting spaces and a business center.

Each room features deluxe amenities, including:

- 42-inch high-definition plasma TV in the bedrooms
- 15-inch LCD TV in the bathrooms
- Bose sound system with iPod connectivity

- Robes and slippers
- Safe
- Iron and ironing board

Standard services available to all rooms include:

- Complimentary access to the workout facility

Specialty Suites

The specialty suites at Red Rock offer an over-the-top VIP experience. The exclusive journey begins when guests arrive and are ushered to a secluded check-in area, then whisked away on a private elevator to the penthouse floor of the hotel. After taking in the magnificent views upon entering the suites, the luxurious surprises continue in the large, modern spaces.

One 80 Penthouse Suite

The One 80 suite is named for the spectacular 180-degree view that includes both the iconic Strip and the majestic Red Rock mountain range. Designed in the style of a contemporary ultra-lounge, the 6,560-square-foot suite is dressed in exquisite materials. A color palette of black, rich browns and deep blues were used to create an air of seduction, sophistication and mystery throughout the space. The suite includes an expansive entertaining area, complete with a

massive bar, 103-inch plasma-screen TV, billiards table, dining table and multiple seating areas; a large terrace that includes a Jacuzzi-style hot tub and rotating sofa; and two bedrooms with adjoining bathrooms and private balconies

Canyon Penthouse Suite

This suite was designed to be a cool and refreshing natural antidote to the heat of the surrounding desert. Floor-to-ceiling windows in every room of the 4,000-square-foot suite provide majestic views of Red Rock Canyon for which the suite was named. Awash in shades of green, the suite offers a spacious entertaining area, featuring a rotating sofa, large bar, dining table and seating area; two sumptuous bedrooms, each with an in-room Jacuzzi-style bathtub, adjoining bathroom and private balcony; and an exclusive massage room for spa treatments

Strip Penthouse Suite

The Strip provides unobstructed views of the Las Vegas Strip, which glimmers in the distance at night. The 3,775-square-foot suite provides a dream-like environment that was designed to encapsulate the glamour and sophistication of old Hollywood. To achieve a light and weightless effect, pale-colored materials were used throughout the entertaining area that includes a large bar, billiards table, dining table and various seating areas, as well as two light and airy bedrooms, each with an in-room Jacuzzi-style bathtub, adjoining bathroom and private balcony

Cherry Penthouse Suite

Designed by New York-based Studio GAIA, the “Cherry” penthouse-level suite features 4,400 square feet of space with four distinct, monochromatic rooms, including a master bedroom, guest bedroom, bar room and living area. The suite captures the feel of a seductive VIP lounge.

To encourage a continuous flow from one room to the next, curtains were used in lieu of doors. Also, a recurring theme of circles can be found throughout the space, from the shape of each room to the custom-made furniture that adorns the suite.

The master bedroom is seeped in magenta and offers a bit of a surprise. The designers played with the convention of the bed as the focal point of a hotel room by positioning it in a cozy alcove with a large, flat-screen TV, and instead, made an eight-foot-in-diameter, glass-enclosed shower with a 24-inch rain shower head the centerpiece of the room. A private bathroom adjoins the room. The second bedroom, decorated in shades of onyx and gold, also has a stunning centerpiece – a round, 10-foot-in-diameter, leather canopy bed. This bedroom also contains a large bathtub that has more than enough room for two people.

The orange bar room was meant for a party. In the center of the room is a large, circular, backlit alabaster bar with seating for eight people. Above the bar are two 50-inch, high-definition plasma TVs with DVD players and surround sound. A large Swarovski crystal chandelier takes center stage above the bar. The living room was designed in a shade of cherry red. It includes a deep, circular sofa, a dining table for eight, as well as a CD/DVD player with surround sound, three 42-inch high-definition plasma TVs and a 20-foot projection video screen with a ceiling-mounted projector. A private patio on the tower’s penthouse level with views of the Strip makes this suite one of a kind.

Lucky Penthouse Suite

Studio GAIA also is responsible for designing the 2,400-square-foot “Lucky” penthouse-level suite. From soft plum to deep aubergine, an all-purple color palette is carried throughout the suite and various textures, including high-polished Venetian plaster, buttery leather and soft suede, are incorporated for visual interest. The space features custom-made furniture and a theme of curvilinear lines.

Two bedrooms flank an oval-shaped living room that is offset at an unexpected 30° angle. The large living room features an unusual convex ceiling, dining table for six and bar with seating for eight. The room is outfitted with modern luxuries, including a 42-inch high-definition plasma TV, CD/DVD player with surround sound, a 20-foot projection video screen with a ceiling-mounted projector and an additional 42-inch high-definition plasma TV behind a bar with surround sound. The spacious master bedroom includes a large, oval-shaped Jacuzzi-style bathtub, as well as a 42-inch, high-definition plasma TV with DVD player. A special feature of the guest bedroom is an in-room, infinity-edge bathtub. In the bathrooms, 17-inch LCD TVs are featured at the vanity and

in the water closet. The private patio offers views of the backyard pool area and the Red Rock mountains.

Top of the Rock and Viva Las Penthouse Suites

The "Top of the Rock" and "Viva" penthouse-level suites were designed by the award-winning design team at Bentel & Bentel. Both 4,400-square-foot suites share a similar open layout and design, but differ in the materials, furniture and color palette. "Top of the Rock" is more masculine with darker colors, such as brown, pumpkin and ochre; walnut wood; sandstone walls and patina bronze. "Viva" is more feminine with shades of citrus, cherry wood, green onyx and stainless steel. The design is extremely modern and luxurious, with rich textures and materials adorning every inch of the suite. But what makes these suites truly breathtaking are the views of the backyard pool area and the Red Rock mountains from the floor-to-ceiling glass walls in every room.

Each suite has two bedrooms, each with a 50-inch high-definition plasma TV. A free-standing two-person, Jacuzzi-style bathtub with an attached fire feature is included in the master bedroom and positioned to take advantage of spectacular view. The attached master bathroom features 17-inch LCD TVs at the vanity and a in the water closet. Two 23-inch LCD TVs are featured in the second bathroom. Between the two bedrooms is a large, sunken living room with an oversized wrap-around couch that borders the room, as well as a lounge area, featuring a large dining table, a bar spanning the length of the room, a 65-inch, high-definition plasma TV, DVD player and surround sound.

Suites

All suites were designed by the Friedmutter Group, in partnership with Anita Brooks of Anita Brooks Interiors, in a contemporary style that was blended with warm colors, fabrics and materials. With 50-inch, high-definition plasma TVs in every bedroom, fully-stocked bars and marble bathrooms, each suite offers guests a modern luxury retreat.

Grand Villa Suite

The two Grand Villa Suite boasts 3,090 square feet of open space. Hues of taupe, paprika and cream fill the suite. Only the finest materials were used in this space, including imported Italian silks, marble flooring and kid-glove leather.

The master bedroom features a king-size bed, 50-inch high-definition plasma TV and adjoining marble "his" and "hers" bathrooms. The "hers" bathroom features a vanity area with a 20-inch LCD TV, deep soaking tub with a 23-inch LCD TV, and a frosted sliding glass door, that, when opened, allows the bedroom to be viewed from the bathtub. The "his" bathroom includes a steam shower with rain shower head. The second bedroom also offers king-size bed and an attached bathroom with a unique spoon-shaped soaking tub.

In the center of the suite is a spacious parlor area which features a private art collection; backlit onyx bar; 42-inch, high-definition plasma TV at the bar; pantry area with a Sub Zero refrigerator; dining table with seating for eight people; custom-made pool table; 65-inch, high-definition plasma TV; CD/DVD player with surround sound; large U-shaped sofa and powder room. The private patio features a large horseshoe-shaped bar, 10-person whirlpool spa, and views of the backyard pool area and the Red Rock mountains.

Villa Suites

The four 2,575-square-foot Villa Suites are some of the most luxurious suites at Red Rock. With a color palette of cinnamon, pistachio and cream, the space is warm and inviting. The master bedroom features a king-size bed and adjoining marble "his" and "hers" bathrooms with features similar to those in the Grand Villa suite. The second bedroom also offers a king-size bed and an attached bathroom with a large bathtub with relaxing jets.

The parlor area includes a backlit onyx bar; 42-inch, high-definition plasma TV at the bar; pantry area with a Sub Zero refrigerator; dining table with seating for 10 people; custom-made pool table; 65-inch, high-definition plasma TV; CD/DVD player with surround sound; large sofa and

powder room. The private patio features a large bar, 10-person whirlpool spa and views of the backyard pool area and Red Rock mountains.

Presidential Suites

Each of the nine Presidential suites provides 2,575 square feet of space and slightly different styling. Some of the suites are drenched in chocolate brown and ruby red, while others are awash in umber and terracotta. Warm hardwood floors can be found in one suite, while another has been laid with polished marble. No matter what the colors or materials, every inch offers the best in contemporary luxury. All suites include two bedrooms; his and hers bathrooms attached to the master bedroom; an additional one and half bathrooms; a parlor with a backlit onyx bar, 42-inch, high-definition plasma TV at the bar, pantry area with a Sub Zero refrigerator, dining table with seating for 10 people, custom-made pool table, 65-inch, high-definition plasma TV, CD/DVD player with surround sound, large sofa and powder room. Some of the presidential suites face the sparkling Strip and the others have clear views of the backyard pool area and the Red Rock mountains.

Luxury Suites

The four luxury suites are 1,545 square feet in size and include a private master bedroom, Calcutta marble master bathroom with a deep soaking tub and large parlor area. Orange Venetian plaster walls and hardwood floors fill the space. The parlor area features a full bar accented with mosaic glass tiles; 65-inch, high-definition plasma TV; dining table for eight people; large sofa and powder room. An adjoining second bedroom and bathroom is available and offers an additional 515 square feet of space.

Signature Suite

The 29 brown and white signature suites are 1,030 square feet and offer a private master bedroom and bathroom, as well as a comfortable parlor area. The parlor area features a wet bar with courtesy refrigerator; 50-inch, high-definition plasma TV; dining table for four people; large sofa and powder room. An adjoining second bedroom and bathroom is available and offers an additional 515 square feet of space.

Canyon-View and Strip-View Guestrooms

Offering 525 square feet of comfortable, modern luxury, all standard guestrooms share a crisp white and chocolate brown color palette with accents of chartreuse and orange. From custom carpets to leather paneling on the bathroom walls, only the finest materials were used in the guestrooms which offer views of either the Strip or the Red Rock mountains. Rooms are available with a king or two queen beds, as well as a 42-inch, high-definition plasma TV, sitting area and work desk. The marble bathroom features a deep soaking tub, separate shower, dual sinks and a 15-inch LCD TV.

Backyard Pool Area

The centerpiece of Red Rock Resort is the backyard pool area, which can be seen from every vantage point within the property. Situated on four acres, the “backyard” offers a main pool with an interactive fountain, a private pool area, cabanas, nine wading pools, an exciting poolside gaming environment featuring blackjack tables, a café and poolside beverage service. To beat the Las Vegas heat, complimentary refreshers, such as popsicles and frozen grapes, are served to guests throughout the day.

Finding a spot to relax in the pool area is never a problem with plenty of lounge chairs, cabanas and numerous “cabeds” available to guests.

The pool area also can serve as an entertainment venue and hosts a variety of public and private events and concerts for as many as 3,000 people. Performances by Sting, Nelly Furtado, Joe Cocker, Kanye West, Toby Keith, the Allman Brothers and the Goo Goo Dolls graced the concert stage over the past few years.

Red Rock Casino, Resort and Spa offers its guests the finest in shopping with Rocks Jewelers by Mordachi, the Red Rock Gift Shop with sundries, logoed apparel, toiletries and gift items, and a Talulah G boutique.
