PROPERTY FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

Santa Fe Station is located on more than 38 acres in northwest Las Vegas, minutes away from the Las Vegas Strip, Red Rock Canyon and Mt. Charleston. Acquired by Station Casinos in 2000, Santa Fe Station features more than 463,000 square feet of gaming, entertainment and hotel space including more than 14,000 square feet of meeting space, 200 hotel rooms, and was named "Best Locals Hotel" 2006 by the Las Vegas Review-Journal.

In the midst of a \$130 million multi-phase expansion, its first since joining the Station Casinos family, a new three-story 900 space parking facility opened June 30, 2006. The second phase garage expansion was completed in November 2006, adding an additional two stories and 2,900 spaces to the existing parking, bringing the total available parking to more than 5,200 self-park and valet spaces. Both garages are accessible through the property's main entrance at North Rancho Drive between Lone Mountain and I-95.

Several amenities in phase three of the property expansion opened in December 2006, including an all new state-of-the-art race and sports book, Feast Buffet, Turf Grill, 400 additional slot and video poker machines and additional meeting and convention space. A new high limit area, larger poker room, new table games area and Salt Lick Bar B-Q opened in March and April 2007. Tides Oyster Bar and 4949 Lounge, a new center bar, are expected to open summer 2007.

DESIGN

Bringing a feeling of southwest splendor to northwest Las Vegas, the look of Santa Fe Station was inspired by an ancient Spanish villa. The interior features earthy tans, reds and browns, marble flooring and wrought-iron accents. The high, open ceilings are accentuated with glass arches. On the property's exterior, the rugged stones and desert landscaping incorporate the natural beauty of the surrounding mountains.



CASINO

DINING

Enjoy one of Santa Fe Station's six full-service restaurants:

- **Charcoal Room Steakhouse & Bar:** Combining creativity and design with award-winning quality and service, the Charcoal Room serves top grade cuts of meat and fresh fish daily, and boasts an extensive wine list and live jazz every Tuesday. Charcoal Room is open for dinner from 5PM to 10PM, Sunday through Thursday, and 5PM to 11PM, Friday and Saturday. Reservations are recommended by calling 702.515.4385.
- **Cabo Mexican Restaurant:** Features authentic Mexican Baja dishes and salsas. Fresh guacamole is prepared tableside, and a variety of margaritas are served up by outrageous flair bartenders. Cabo is open for dinner from 4PM to 10PM, Monday through Friday, lunch and dinner from 12PM to 11PM, Saturday, and 12PM to 10PM, Sunday. The bar at Cabo remains open until midnight daily.
- **Salt Lick Bar B-Q:** The second Las Vegas location (first opened at Red Rock Resort) of Texas' world-famous BBQ restaurant, founded in 1969, serving up Southern classics such as ribs, brisket, turkey and its legendary cobbler. Dry-rubbed BBQ is smoked on property, just as it is in Driftwood, TX. Salt Lick is open for dinner from 4PM to 10PM, Monday through Thursday, lunch and dinner from 11AM to 11PM, Friday and Saturday, and 11AM to 10PM, Sunday.
- **Turf Grill:** Eat in or carry out a fresh Philly Cheese steak, club sandwich, hamburger and hotdogs, steak and eggs, and other comfort foods. Turf Grill is open from 8AM to 11PM, Sunday through Thursday, and 8AM to 12AM, Friday and Saturday.
- **Feast Buffet:** Freshly prepared food offerings from around the world, featuring five live-action cooking stations and serving Italian, Chinese, Mexican, BBQ and a live-action dessert station. Breakfast is served from 8AM to 11AM, lunch from 11AM to 4PM on weekdays, and dinner from 4PM to 10PM daily. Weekend brunch is served from 8AM to 4PM.
- **Grand Café:** Station Casinos' popular 24-hour casual American bistro.

ENTERTAINMENT

- **Chrome Showroom:** An intimate 650 seat venue featuring a varied lineup of headliners and some of the best jazz and blues artists touring the country, including Starship with Mickey Thomas, The Tubes, Corey Stevens, Maynard Ferguson, and Arturo Sandoval. Purple Reign—The Prince Tribute Show puts on a spectacular performance every Friday and Saturday night.
- **Bars and Lounges:** Santa Fe Station features several bars and lounges open 24 hours a day, including Iguana Bar and the Sports Bar.
