PROPERTY FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

Texas Station is located less than ten minutes from the Las Vegas Strip on 47 acres in North Las Vegas, one of the fastest growing cities in the U.S. Opened in 1995, Texas Station is the Company's third property and features 270,000 square feet of gaming, entertainment and hotel space including more than 42,000 square feet of meeting space, two 1,000 square foot wedding chapels, and two garages offering more than 4,400 parking spaces, accessible via north and south entrances.



With award-winning restaurants, 200 hotel rooms, a 60-lane bowling facility, exciting table games and more than 2,300 slot and video poker machines, the AAA Diamond-rated Texas Station offers all of the best of Las Vegas under one roof.

DESIGN

Texas Station brings all of the grandeur of the Lone Star state to Las Vegas, from the oil rig in the parking lot to the cattle brand-inspired light sconces throughout the casino. There's even a full-size, cherry red, 1976 Cadillac convertible, complete with steer-horn hood ornament, perched above one of the casino's many bars and lounges.

- **Texas Star Oyster Bar:** Prepared at live-action stations right before your eyes, Texas Star offers perfectly steamed clams, freshly shucked oysters, homemade chowders and gumbos, and seafood pastas daily.
